21	<p>I am a final year high school student enrolled in an English Medium School in Cyprus. Can I apply for a foundation programme for PG/UG 2 scholarship?</p>	<p>Yes. As per page 7, Section 3 of the Guidelines:</p> <p>Who can apply for PD/UG-2?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Final year high school/vocational school students studying at any high school located in Cyprus and expecting to graduate in 2018/19 academic year. • Graduates of any high/vocational school located in Cyprus.

		<p>What can you study under PD/UG-2?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Prep/Foundation programme, e.g. year 0• Any official EU language course <p>Conditions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Those studying at and graduates of English speaking high schools can apply for any EU language course except English.• Those studying at and graduates of Turkish speaking high/vocational schools can apply for any EU language course including English.
