To enable us to make payment to you, you must be set up on our on-line accounting system (SAP). Your full bank details are needed for this purpose.

Please log into your portal to complete the bank details form. (<https://apply.abburs.eu/default.aspx>). Select **BANK DETAILS** on the left side of your screen to complete the form. Areas marked with * **below** are compulsory.

Once you complete the form on your portal save the form. Print **PDF** version and sign it. Please configure your web browser to allow pop-up windows. Scan and upload the signed document on the portal under **Documents Upload** on the Home page of your portal.
